

Agility Workshop Descriptions

November 18 Tuesday - Tunnelers agility night

Like a fun run - except you get help from the judge on how to optimize your handling. Tunnelers courses consist of tunnels and hoops only leading to a fast and fun game of agility twister.

Prerequisite: For all teams who have completed one or more sessions of the More Agility Puzzles class or Sport Agility Handling class or equivalent experience.

6:00-7:30pm - Tunnelers round 1

7:30-9:00pm - Tunnelers round 2 (this will be a new course so if you want to sign up for both classes, you can)

November 19 Wednesday - Sport Agility Obstacle Training - session 1

Come get an overview of the complete process on how to train weave poles and/or contact obstacles for competitive level performance. Bring your dogs and get started with the process. Simple homework exercises will help you make great progress over the winter.

Prerequisite: For all teams who have completed the Sport Agility Handling class or equivalent experience.

7:30-9:00pm - Contact obstacles (teeter, a-frame, dogwalk)

December 9 Tuesday - Jumpers agility night

Like a fun run - except you get help from the judge on how to optimize your handling. These courses will have only low jumps, so it will keep you moving and challenge your handling skills. Having only low jumps will challenge your handling skills to the max.

Prerequisite: For all teams who have completed one session of the More Agility Puzzles class or Sport Agility Handling class or equivalent experience.

7:30-9:00pm - Jumpers round 2 (this will be a new course so if you want to sign up for both classes, you can)

December 10 Wednesday - Sport Agility Obstacle Training - session 2

This is a follow up to the session 1 class and a continuation of the competition-level obstacle training process

Prerequisite: Sport Agility Obstacle Training -session 1

6:00 - 7:30pm - Weave poles

7:30-9:00pm - Contact obstacles (teeter, a-frame, dogwalk)

December 16 Tuesday - Touch-n-go agility night

Like a fun run - except you get help from the judge on how to optimize your handling. These courses will have dogwalk and a-frame + tunnels and hoops (no teeter).

Prerequisite: For all teams who have completed one session of the More Agility Puzzles class or sport handling class or equivalent.

6:00-7:30pm - Touch-n-go round 1

7:30-9:00pm - Touch-n-go round 2 (this will be a new course so if you want to sign up for both classes, you can)

December 17 Wednesday - Agility Handling night

Distance Handling and Obstacle Discrimination are two skills that can help you solve more complex agility puzzles. Come learn how to teach your dog and how to handle your dog through these kinds of challenges.

Prerequisite: For all teams who have completed one session of the More Agility Puzzles class or Sport Agility Handling class or equivalent experienc.

7:30-9:00pm - Obstacle Discrimination - make choices between two obstacles
